#### A GUIDE TO ENDOWMENT FUNDS

This is the fourth edition of the Endowment Funds Report for the SUNY New Paltz Foundation. This report lists funds currently held, their purpose, and the market value of each (principal plus accumulated earnings and appreciation), as of the close of our fiscal year 2019, which ended on June 30, 2019. All funds include a six-digit Foundation account number following the description, providing donors a quick reference when making a donation or inquiring about a fund.


There are three kinds of endowed funds listed in this book:

- A **general endowed scholarship fund**, with no restrictions, established with a minimum gift of \$25,000.
- A **restricted scholarship endowment fund** established with a minimum gift of \$40,000.
- A program endowment fund established with a minimum gift of \$50,000.

The funds in this book are organized first by the School with which they are associated. These sections are followed by funds affiliated with: Experiential Learning, Research, and Study Abroad; funds designated for the Samuel Dorsky Museum of Art; and, lastly, general funds or ones serving a unique audience or purpose.

- Interwoven among the endowments are funds marked **in development**. These funds have been created and are in the process of attaining the current minimum thresholds to become fully endowed.
- Funds **marked with an asterisk (\*)** were created before our current endowment threshold was established. Though considered fully endowed, they do not produce a spendable balance to use for their designated purpose and are opportunities for further philanthropic support.

Endowments help support the educational programs that benefit our students and our community. The earnings and market appreciation of an endowed fund benefit the College, our faculty, and our students in perpetuity. The investment objectives of the SUNY New Paltz Foundation are to manage its funds in a manner that will maximize the benefit intended by the donor and to generate a total return on assets to support the programs of the College.



### BERNARD ARATOWSKY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Market Value \$30,445

Established in 1986 through the generosity of family, friends, and faculty members of the Department of History and the Department of Languages, Literatures and Cultures. This award is designed to commemorate the contributions made by Dr. Aratowsky to promote the study of the classics. 304701

#### ANTHONY BRIGANDI ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Market Value \$29,391

Established by Mr. Peter Brigandi '92 in support of travel scholarships for students studying in SUNY New Paltz's Institute for Disaster Mental Health (IDMH), enabling IDMH to provide more students the opportunity to supply direct disaster services to victims in devastated communities. 304137

#### KAREN KRAUSE BRODY '71 AND DR. STEVEN BRODY '73 SCHOLARSHIP

Market Value \$55,425

Established in 2012 through the generosity of Karen Krause Brody '71 '80g and Dr. Steven Brody '73 to provide emergency aid to junior or senior students in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences whose ability to continue at New Paltz is threatened by a sudden change in financial circumstances, such as parental job loss. 304207

Established through the generosity of Thomas and Joan Casey in memory of their son, Thomas Joseph Casey '11, to provide scholarship support to one or more rising seniors majoring in journalism who bring passion, energy, and integrity to their profession. 304138

# RUSSELL S. CLEVERLEY MEMORIAL FELLOWSHIP ENDOWMENT

Market Value \$63,922

Established in 2001 by Luella and Donald Cleverley to honor the memory of their son, Russell S. Cleverley '95g. This fellowship is open only to students accepted and matriculated in the Master of Arts, English program; preference will be given to applicants writing a thesis. 304861

# LEONARD EISENBERG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Market Value \$17,058\*

Established in 1992 through the generosity of family and friends, in memory of Dr. Leonard Eisenberg of the Department of Anthropology. The scholarship was created to help students majoring in anthropology with an interest in archeology. 304047

### FRIENDS OF ASIAN STUDIES ENDOWMENT

Market Value \$172,609

Established in 2005 by Asian Studies alumni and friends of Asian Studies, the endowment supports initiatives the Asian Studies program deems most beneficial to Asian Studies majors. Fundable initiatives include student scholarships, as well as activities such as undergraduate involvement in faculty research, independent student research, and travel support for study abroad opportunities in Asia. 303098

### WILLIAM HAUBER SCHOLARSHIP

Market Value \$12,690\*

Established in 1993 in memory of William C. Hauber '85 by family, friends, and alumni to encourage the continued study of the German language and the achievement of academic excellence for fully matriculated students majoring in German. 304090

### ELEANOR KUYKENDALL ENDOWED LECTURE SERIES

Market Value \$11,304\*

Established in 1994 by friends and colleagues in memory of Eleanor Kuykendall, professor of philosophy (1967–1993). The endowment is to be used to fund lectures in philosophy, including lectures in Professor Kuykendall's areas of scholarly interest: 20th century French philosophy, philosophy of language, and feminist theory. 306846

### PAUL F. MURPHY SCHOLARSHIP

Market Value \$7,323\*

Established in 1985 by his family and friends and named for the late Judge Paul F. Murphy. The recipient must be a graduating senior, majoring in pre-law. Preference is given to year-round residents of the mid-Hudson region. 304805

#### JUDY PAIGE O'BRIEN '70 AND THOMAS O'BRIEN '70 LIBERAL ARTS AND SCIENCES INTERNSHIP SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Market Value \$1,973,170

Established in 2000 by Mr. James '18 HON & Mrs. Mary '70g Ottaway. The holder of the professorship will be designated as the James H. Ottaway Sr. Professor. The professorship will be held by distinguished journalists who will come to the SUNY New Paltz campus for periods of up to one year to engage students and the community in lectures, seminars, or formal courses about the craft of journalism in all forms.

#### MILDRED AND LOUIS RESNICK JEWISH LIFE LECTURE SERIES

Market Value \$431,638

Established in 1989 to enable the College and community to benefit in perpetuity from the presence of distinguished lecturers in the area of Jewish Studies and Jewish cultural traditions. 306845

#### DR. CHIGURUPATI SESHU MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IN ECONOMICS

Market Value \$47,146

Established in 2003, through the generosity of family and friends of Professor Chigurupati Rama Seshu. A member of the Department of Economics and Business Administration beginning in 1967, Seshu was also director of institutional research from 1974 to 1977. This scholarship will help support economics majors in the junior and senior year. 304103

Established through the combination of contributions to the art program at SUNY New Paltz memorializing alumnus Cary Coffing, Professor Herbert L. Kammerer, and Professor Alex Minewski. This scholarship supports talented SUNY New Paltz art students.

Cary Coffing was a talented emerging artist who loved New Paltz. He enjoyed participating in many activities, and is remembered by friends for his sense of humor and school spirit. He died in a tragic accident on August 11, 1966, as he returned from Accord, New York on his motorcycle. Family, classmates, and friends established a scholarship fund in his memory to support SUNY New Paltz art students.

Alex Minewski was a professor of painting at SUNY New Paltz and dedicated his life to abstract expressionism. Upon his passing in 1979, the New Paltz community of faculty and friends established a scholarship in his memory.

Herbert Lewis Kammerer, professor at SUNY New Paltz, was known as a world-class sculptor. Family and friends established a scholarship fund to provide support for art students who demonstrate excellence as sculptors. 304300

#### JOE AND JEAN BADALUCCO OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT THEATRE SCHOLARSHIP

Market Value \$74,877

Established in 2006 through a bequest in memory of Professor Emeritus Frank Eckelt and his wife, Gertrude. This scholarship was established to support a senior showing outstanding ability in the fine arts, preferably in the field of sculpture. 304030

#### JOHN L. AND JEANNE L. FITZGERALD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Market Value \$55,977

Established in 2001 in honor of John L. and Jeanne L. Fitzgerald by their family (Everton H. Henriques '78 '83g, Jeannie Irvine '78, Tamsin (Fitzgerald) Wolf, and Michael Fitzgerald), for their love, support, and commitment to providing cultural enlightenment, through John's acting and art work and Jeanne's poetry and music. Eligible candidates must be matriculated students majoring in theater or music. 304044

### MARION HARDING SCHOLARSHIP

Market Value \$67,652

Established in 1992 by friends and family in honor of Marion Harding, who joined the faculty in 1928 and retired in 1964. Her final contribution to the Department of Music was a generous bequest, which provides the Marion Harding Scholarships for applied music lessons. Recipients will be chosen by Department of Music faculty on the basis of demonstrated financial need, skill, and effort. 304769

#### THE McKENNA PRODUCTIONS SCHOLARSHIPS

The following six endowed scholarships, honoring six extraordinary and beloved Department of Theatre Arts professors at SUNY New Paltz, were made possible by gifts from McKenna Productions. From 1973 to 2004, McKenna Productions produced all major departmental theatrical productions on campus; these gifts are a result of continued community support and past ticket sales at McKenna Theatre.

#### DR. BEVERLY M. BRUMM ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Market Value \$47,754

This fund was created in 2003, as a result of gifts that were made in honor of retired Theatre Professor Beverly Brumm, and brought to the endowment threshold by a generous gift from McKenna Productions. The fund was set up to help students in the theatre program. 304310

#### PROFESSOR DAN E. SWARTZ ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Market Value \$47,855

Established in 2016 to support theatre majors entering their senior year, one with a concentration in lighting and one with a concentration in sound. 304311




